

Transport

As part of the national response to COVID-19, the NZ Transport Agency will implement free fares for Total Mobility customers, up to the regional fare subsidy cap (this is \$40 in Auckland), from Tuesday 14 April 2020.

The fare subsidy is for the transportation of Total Mobility customers with permanent disabilities only.

The free fares are to ensure access to essential services and the ability for essential workers to access their workplace.

This aligns with the similar COVID-19 fare-free public transport policy.

This subsidy will continue while New Zealand is at COVID-19 pandemic response alert levels 3 and 4, up until 30 June.
