As a result, the Government announced at 9.00pm last night that the whole of Auckland will move from Alert Level 1 to **Alert Level 3 for the next 7 days from 6.00am this morning.**

That means that where possible you should keep your children home from school for this period.

- We will be open on Monday 1st March for those of you who have no other options but to send your children to school due to being an essential worker or your child is unable to be supervised at home.
- We will have safety precautions in place to look after them.
- The ministry has said in their latest correspondence that only children who can't be supervised at home by an appropriate person, are able to attend school.

If your child is unable to be supervised at home we recommend that you register the need for them to attend our Base school.
