

Community update 01/03/2022

Kia ora e te whānau

We have seen a large increase in the number of COVID-19 cases since we moved into Phase 3 last week. We want to assure our Oaklynn community that we expected this and that we are prepared. We have a pool of relievers, therapists and staff members being used across the school to cover and support in place of those that are absent. By doing this, we have not needed to close any further classes at this stage.

By following the Ministry of Education guidelines we have managed to so far avoid transmission within the school, although positive Covid cases in our community are growing in numbers. Please continue to keep your child/young person home if they are presenting with cold or flu-like symptoms and get them tested. Children are to stay home if a member of their household tests positive for COVID-19. If your child/young person at Oaklynn School tests positive for COVID-19, please contact your class teacher as soon as possible.

As there has been, and continues to be, so much disruption - we have decided to cancel our Staff Only Day. The day was originally scheduled for Friday 18th of March. This will now be a regular school day.

There will be a vaccination clinic here at Base school for students, whānau and staff on Wednesday the 23rd of March. You will receive more information, about this day, via the Health and Safety email before the end of this week.
